

M. Valcarcel-Saez is a Catalan multidisciplinary artist, musician, and writing subject with an inclination for science. Obtained a Master of Fine Art from Goldsmiths University of London in 2016, and a Mixed Media Fine Art bachelors degree in 2014. Previously studied computer science, drama, music and opera (lyric mezzo-soprano) and completed the first cycle of a Humanities degree in Barcelona, Italy, Germany, and the UK. Currently based in London and Barcelona.

Valcarcel-Saez uses sound, digital and literary tools to explore the subject's performativity and the self-representation of the author. Video, web and installation with performance are preferred means, while electronic noise/music, words and singing are incorporated as part of either. Recent work includes performances in Taiwan, Lithuania, France and the United Kingdom. A project in Spain was cancelled in October 2017 for political reasons.

Also working with poetry and narrative, the *Bath Flash Fiction Anthology 2017* was published last winter including Valcarcel-Saez's work.
